# City Wants Input on How SA Can Become Bicycle Friendly

Do you bicycle? Where do you bike? How frequently do you bike, and, most importantly, what improvements can be made that would convince you to bike more, and would convince others to bike? You're asked to participate in a survey for the SA Tomorrow effort which will help determine how bicycling will fit into the city's long term master plan, News Radio 1200 WOAI reports.

"The more input we get from the community, the better we can plan for them today and in the future," said Jillian Harris, the City's senior

transportation planner. "We hope people will give us a few minutes of their time to answer our survey questions about bicycling in San Antonio."


Statistics show that about one in four San Antonio residents rides a bicycle at least once a month, mainly for recreation or exercise.

And 11% of San Antonians commute to work or school by bicycle.

The survey asks cyclists to discuss their preferred types of bicycle infrastructure, safety, ways to encourage more riding, and how car drivers can be urged to be more accepting of cyclists. It also asks people what prevents them from bicycling, whether it is weather, stray dogs, crime, or lack of bicycle infrastructure.

An update to the city's bicycle master plan is expected next year.


